

CARE TIPS FOR AIR PLANTS

AIR PLANTS ARE UNIQUE PLANTS THAT DON'T REQUIRE SOIL TO GROW, MAKING THEM EASY TO CARE FOR IF YOU FOLLOW SOME BASIC GUIDELINES:

1. LIGHT REQUIREMENTS

AIR PLANTS THRIVE IN BRIGHT, INDIRECT SUNLIGHT. PLACE THEM NEAR A WEST-FACING WINDOW WHERE THEY CAN GET PLENTY OF LIGHT, BUT AVOID DIRECT SUN EXPOSURE AS IT CAN SCORCH THEIR LEAVES.

2. WATERING

WATERING IS CRUCIAL SINCE THEY DON'T ABSORB WATER THROUGH ROOTS. SUBMERGE THEM IN WATER FOR 20-30 MINUTES ONCE A WEEK. IF YOUR ENVIRONMENT IS DRY, YOU MIGHT NEED TO MIST THEM LIGHTLY BETWEEN WATERINGS. AFTER SOAKING, SHAKE OFF ANY EXCESS WATER TO PREVENT ROT AND ALLOW THEM TO DRY UPSIDE DOWN.

3. AIR CIRCULATION

GOOD AIR CIRCULATION IS ESSENTIAL. AFTER WATERING, ENSURE THEY ARE PLACED IN A LOCATION WITH GOOD AIRFLOW TO HELP THEM DRY OUT COMPLETELY WITHIN A FEW HOURS.

4. TEMPERATURE

AIR PLANTS PREFER TEMPERATURES BETWEEN 50-90°F (10-32°C). THEY ARE NOT FROST-TOLERANT, SO KEEP THEM INDOORS.

5. FERTILIZATION

USE AIR PLANT FERTILIZER QUARTERLY DURING THEIR GROWING SEASON. DILUTE THE FERTILIZER TO HALF-STRENGTH AND APPLY IT BY MISTING OR ADDING TO THE WATER DURING SOAKING.

WITH THESE CARE TIPS, YOUR AIR PLANTS SHOULD THRIVE AND POSSIBLY EVEN PRODUCE PUPS (BABY AIR PLANTS) THAT YOU CAN PROPAGATE.



AIR PLANTS: NATURE'S HANGING WONDERS

AIR PLANTS (TILLANDSIA) ARE UNIQUE PLANTS THAT DON'T REQUIRE SOIL TO GROW. THEY ABSORB NUTRIENTS AND MOISTURE FROM THE AIR THROUGH THEIR LEAVES.

FOUND NATURALLY IN CENTRAL AND SOUTH AMERICA, AIR PLANTS THRIVE IN A VARIETY OF ENVIRONMENTS, FROM RAINFORESTS TO DESERTS.

NO SOIL NEEDED: GROW WITHOUT SOIL, MAKING THEM VERSATILE FOR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR DÉCOR.

LOW MAINTENANCE: EASY TO CARE FOR, NEEDING ONLY OCCASIONAL MISTING OR SOAKING AND BRIGHT,

INDIRECT LIGHT.

CREATIVE DISPLAY: MOUNT THEM ON WOOD, ROCKS, SHELLS, OR IN TERRARIUMS TO CREATE UNIQUE LIVING ART.

SPACE-SAVING: IDEAL FOR SMALL SPACES, AS THEY CAN HANG, SIT ON SHELVES, OR BE USED IN VERTICAL GARDENS.

FUN FACTS ABOUT AIR PLANTS

DIVERSE FAMILY: OVER 600 SPECIES OF AIR PLANTS, EACH WITH ITS OWN UNIQUE LOOK.

BLOOM ONCE: AIR PLANTS PRODUCE VIBRANT FLOWERS, TYPICALLY ONCE IN THEIR LIFETIME, WHICH CAN LAST FROM DAYS TO MONTHS.

PUPS FOR PROPAGATION: AFTER BLOOMING, AIR PLANTS PRODUCE OFFSETS, KNOWN AS "PUPS," THAT CAN BE SEPARATED AND GROWN INTO NEW PLANTS.
